Does your child have a pile of paperback books sitting in their room that they have already read? Do you wish you had the opportunity to exchange them for more exciting reading materials? This Book Swap is for you!

How it Works

- January 3 to January 8: Students may bring in any “gently used” paperback books to the office for donation. We will track the number of picture books, chapter books, and non-fiction books brought in by each student.
- Students may come to the APR and select any “gently used” books of their choice based on the number of books

- Please note that the selection of books available will be based on books donated.
- We cannot ensure specific titles, etc.
- Students will be given a ticket letting them know what they can receive that night at the swap as well as any books that don't meet criteria will be returned. For example, if a 5th grader turns in 3 picture books, they must leave with 3 picture books. (This ensures that everyone is exchanging in a fair manner.)

Book Criteria

Please make choices carefully before bringing in books. Books will only be accepted under the following guidelines:

- Books must be paperback and appropriate for grades PreK-5 only.
- Books must be in gently used condition: cover on, no rips, tears, or bent edges.
- Books with coloring or writing in them will not be accepted.
- Coloring books, activity books, and sticker books will not be accepted.
- Books from kids’ meals will not be accepted (Chick-fil-a, McDonald's, etc.)
